Starting on April 11, open burning in the SRA will required a permit from Cal Fire. These permits can be obtained on-line. All indications at this point are leading to open burning coming to a close for hazard reduction on April 30th.

Significant structure fire on 3/19/22 on Spring Hill School Rd. Fortunately, no civilian or fire department injuries. We were able to obtain surveillance camera footage from the resident which appears to confirm the fire started approximately 15 minutes prior to anyone at the residence recognizing there was an incident (fire first noticed at 11:42pm and appears that residents noticed the incident at approximately 11:57pm.

COVID-19

Cases continue to trend downward county-wide. As of Monday evening, there were only 8 people hospitalized county wide with none in the ICU. We had no reported COVID cases amongst our Gold Ridge membership for the month of March. The latest updated health order as it pertains to our department is as follows: Unvaccinated personnel have to test for COVID once per week and wear a mask if they indoors in an area with more than one person as well as traveling in department vehicles with more than one person. Boosted and unboosted personnel do not have to wear a mask nor do they have to test unless they are exhibiting COVID symptoms.
